It may take up to four weeks to process a request for a Vehicle Registration Certificate for Export.

The export VRC will be sent to the address registered in the register of motor vehicles. If you want the export VRC to be sent to a different address, [you must book an appointment at your local Driver and Vehicle Licensing Office \(trafikkstasjon\)](#), bring the application form, provide identification, and ask the clerk to order a Vehicle Registration Certificate for Export. You can also upload your ID and documentation along with the application form in [the contact form for VRCs and number plates.](#)
